1. Can you see any false teachings in this passage?
2. Whether it's a New Moon festival or the worship of angels, how do the things Paul lists affect our salvation?
3. According to verse 22, what will happen to these things? Why will such things perish?

4. Why do you think these things lack value in the Christian life, like Paul says in verse 23?
5. Are there similar teachings out there today? How can we distinguish between heresy and truth?
